PROVIDER TRAINING ON CLINICAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RUBI PARENT TRAINING FOR DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR CURRICULUM

This training is for ABA therapists, clinical Psychologists, and other professionals trained in behavioral intervention for children with ASD.

The webinar series will introduce you to the RUBI Parent Training Program, review the key elements and treatment components, offer ongoing support and consultative services, and discussion on clinical implementation, with an emphasis on adaptations for telehealth.

The goal of the webinar series is to familiarize trainees with the components of the RUBI Parent Training Program and provide ongoing support for clinical utilization and implementation. The Utah RUBI Autism ECHO Network hopes to increase availability and access of evidence-based parent training programs for families of children with autism and co-occurring challenging behaviors throughout the state.

What is RUBI?

RUBI is a structured parent training program for children with ASD and disruptive behaviors. The program is based on principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and is designed for use by clinicians with experience working with children with ASD and co-occurring challenging behaviors

What Is Included in the Training?

Introductory workshops, case consultation sessions, and a free RUBI Therapist manual. Additionally, all participants will receive a certificate of completion, and training handouts.
